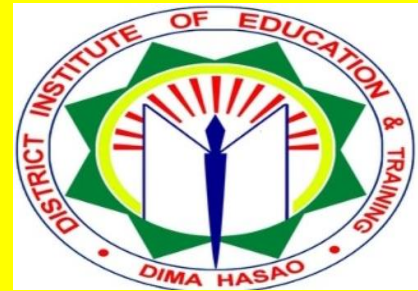

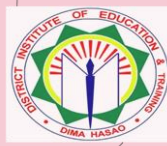

From the Principal Desk



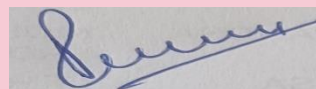

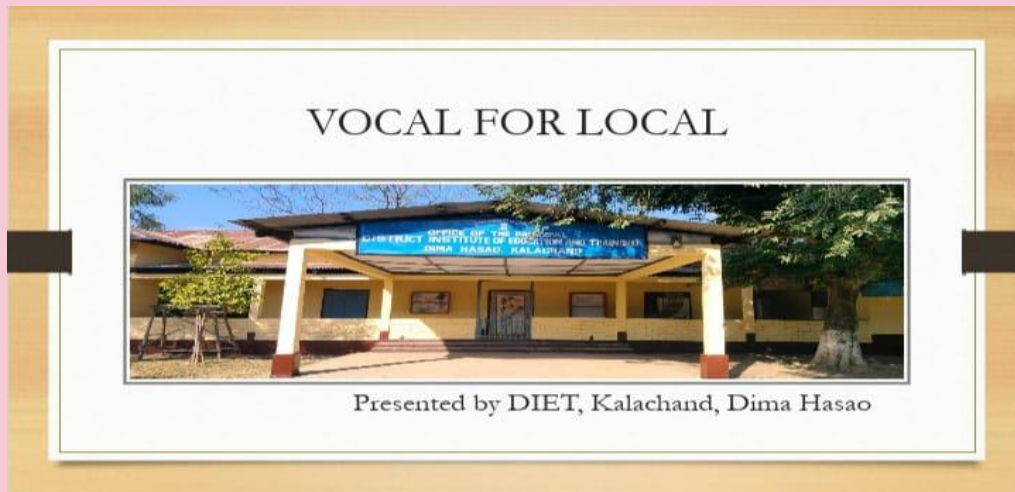
December, 2025
